



ADMISSIONS AND FINANCIAL AID

Bryan University offers you a supportive and structured experience from the time you enroll through graduation. Admissions and Financial Assistance personnel are available to answer your questions about programs of study and to help you explore your options to make college a reality.

ACADEMICS

You will be assigned a dedicated advisor. Your Program Oversight Chair is a mentor dedicated to assisting you on your journey through your program. They develop a one-on-one relationship with you to build successful strategies and habits, and to work with you through all the courses in your program.

Your instructors are training professionals and will teach you industry skills needed by businesses and organizations across the U.S. Instructors work with students individually and in small groups to provide guidance and feedback on your learning mastery path.

1 WHAT YOU NEED

BU Online classes are designed for maximum compatibility and minimal hardware requirements. A good rule of thumb is to use a laptop or desk-top computer that is five years old or newer with a cable/DSL broadband connection (756MB or faster). Laptops already come with wireless hardware that let you connect to Wi-Fi.

Windows, Mac, and Linux operating systems are compatible with online classes. Students can also access their classes via the Canvas App, available for iOS and Android devices.

You'll also need to be able to access video chat software at some point to take part in class discussions.

Consider finding a quiet space or using noise-canceling headphones so you can focus on the topics being discussed in your virtual classroom.

REMOTE/VIDEO CLASSROOMS

Instructors may hold weekly class discussions to peruse course material, answer student questions, and help you understand class concepts. You can talk to your instructor and discuss items with your classmates through video chat sessions on your computer or mobile device.

COLLABORATING WITH CLASSMATES

Students and teachers work together in the classroom using a wide range of interactive tools such as live conferences, video chat, and discussion boards with video record capabilities so students in different time-zones can communicate more easily. In addition, you can use traditional tools like messaging and email to collaborate with their teacher and fellow students.
